MINDDRIVE EXPERIENCE: Monday - Thursday 9 AM - 12:30 PM, June 12-15

MINDDRIVE will be offering a course for soon to be freshmen called the MINDDRIVE Experience. This course will cover topics used during MINDDRIVE through the school year and will work in the Productions and Automotice Design Studios. Students will have a different project each day with a hands-on projects in Photography, Videography, Drones, and Robotics. **Open to incoming Freshmen only.**

Music Video Production Monday - Thursday 1 PM - 4 PM, June 12-15

Students who love music will love this crash course in video editing! Using music to provide a backdrop, students will learn to capture and edit together video in a range of Adobe programs.

Robotics: Monday - Thursday 9 AM - 12:30 PM, June 19-23

Students interested in the wide world of robotics will work to build a robot in one week at MINDDRIVE. The project will be hands-on and students will get to walk through the process of creating a robot in the Automotive Design Studio at MINDDRIVE HQ.

Automotive: Saturdays 9 AM - 1 PM, June 17 - July 8

Students that are interested in automotive design are encouraged to take part in our Saturday class in Automotive. Students will learn about the electric vehicles that MINDDRIVE has made and will help in keeping them updated and running. The class will work in the Automotive Design Studio at MINDDRIVE HQ.

Drone: Monday - Thursday 9 AM - 12:30 PM, June 26-29

In the ever changing world of technology, drones have become a popular topic for collecting video. In this short course, students will have hands-on experience in flying drones and collecting footage to edit together using programs in the Adobe Creative Suite.

Stop Motion Animation: Monday - Thursday 1 PM - 4 PM, June 19-29

Before film and video there was photography and stop-motion animation. Stop-motion animation (aka motion graphics) is a specialized branch of art and design focused on time based media, visual art, physics and imaging technology - with roots in communication, science and culture. MINDDRIVE will offer a course in animation over two weeks where students will work hands-on to create a short stop-motion animation video.
